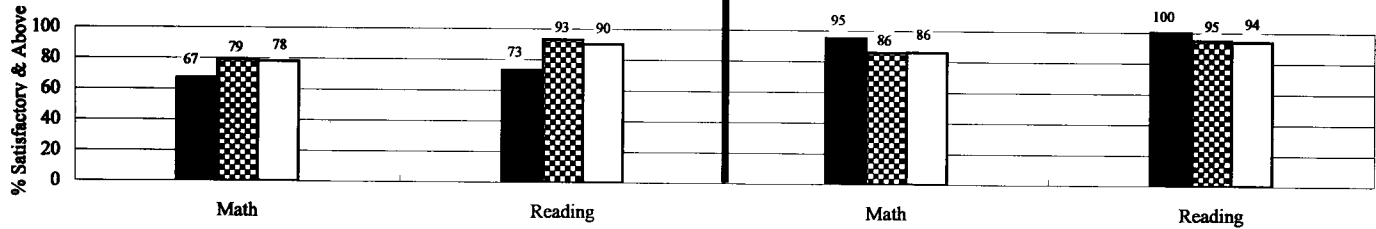


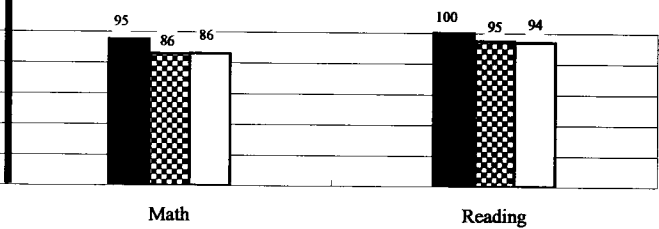

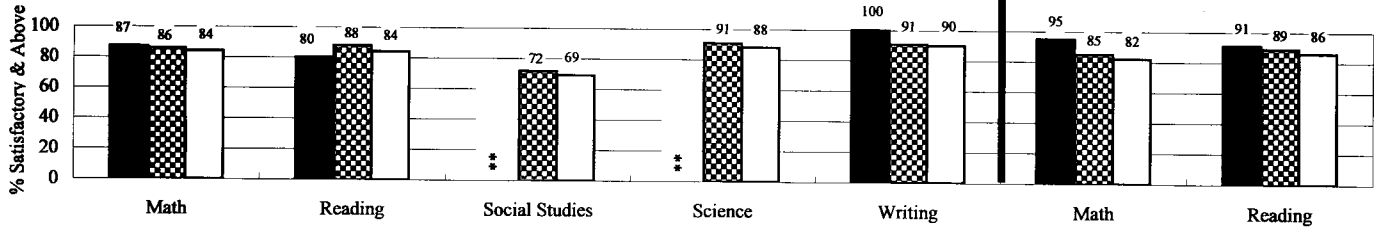
3rd Grade Tests *



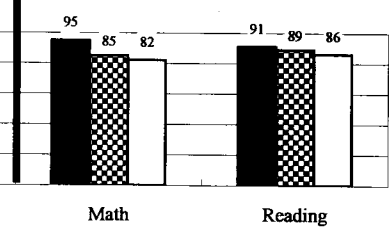
4th Grade Tests *



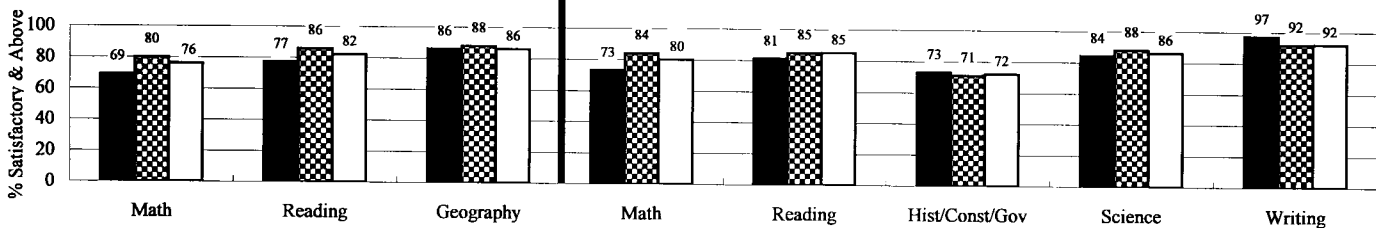
